When classes are in session, volunteers for this option should park in the Shuttle Lot located at 4828 Lake Road and use the Express Shuttle to commute to and from campus. The shuttle will run 7 am – midnight, Monday – Friday in a 20-minute loop, making stops at the shuttle lot, Tower Fine Arts, Lot L (Admissions), and Allen Administration Building. Understanding that there will be times when you need your car close by, volunteers will be given 8 day passes for use per semester. Volunteers may park on campus when classes are not in full session (mid-semester break, winter break, summer, etc.), after 6:30 pm Monday – Thursday, after 3 pm on Fridays, and on weekends. Please complete the back of this form to indicate what days/times you plan to be on campus during the fall semester.

Parking Rules and Regulations

Responsibility is placed on me to park where I am authorized under the Parking Rules and Regulations of The College at Brockport, State University of New York and the following stipulations are agreed upon:

1. General regulations: All persons operating motor vehicles on The College at Brockport campus are responsible for knowing and understanding the rules, regulations and policies for parking on campus. Ignorance of the contents of these rules is neither excuse nor extenuation for violations.
2. A parking permit carries no guarantee or liability of the College or BASC to provide the holder at any given time with a parking space. The College and BASC cannot accept any responsibility for damage to or theft of any motor vehicle or its contents while parked on campus or at the Express Shuttle Lot.
3. All vehicles considered to be illegally operated and/or parked will be subject to a charge and/or being towed away or immobilized at the driver's expense.
4. The complimentary day passes provided as part of this program are for the volunteers use only. Scratch off the month and day before displaying the tag.
5. This parking permit is non-transferable to any other vehicle (unless properly registered with Welcome Center & Parking Services) or for another person's use. I understand the hangtag must be properly displayed from the rear-view mirror of my vehicle at all times while parked on campus. My parking privileges may be suspended if I share my permit with another person.
6. If I fail to transfer my hangtag from vehicle to vehicle, I must obtain a temporary pass. This courtesy will be extended the first two times free of charge. After that a fee will be imposed.
7. I understand that I am liable for all violations issued against this parking permit(s). The use of payroll deduction for faculty/staff will be used as a means of collecting past due fines. I further understand the use of a collection agency will be used if deemed appropriate.
8. All information given on this document is correct to the best of my knowledge.
