To comply with the New York State Textbook Access Act (Education Law 720 et seq.), the Bookstore along with Registration and Records and Information Technology Services have made the following enhancements to the course registration process for students:

Beginning this semester when students register for either winter or spring 2010 courses, a listing of required course materials will be available from a link on the Online Course Schedule page and the Registration page in Web Banner. These links will connect directly to the Barnes & Noble College Bookstore Web site where students will have the opportunity to view textbook information including costs, and, if desired, can purchase the materials required for their intended classes.

This new registration and textbook integration feature will be available to students beginning **November 5**. As always, students may view a list of their required and recommended texts at any time by visiting www.brockport.bkstore.com.
